Education

- Education staff lead interactive trainings for teachers, students, youth, parents, special populations, clergy and health professionals.
- Educator/trainers are located in Merrillville, Lafayette, Fort Wayne, Indianapolis, Bloomington and Columbus.
- Peer Education trains teens and young adults to answer their peers' questions about sexuality issues.
- Teen Success is a support network and mentoring program for parenting teens.
- The Resource Center—open to the public—contains more than 2,500 books, videos and teaching aids.
- The Family Pages and Teen website provide interactive learning modules on sexual health.
- AskMe! answers questions sent by visitors to our website.
- Educators seek outreach opportunities to participate and educate at community-based events.

Public Policy

According to a recent Guttmacher study, Indiana ranks 49th in a survey of states' efforts to help women avoid unintended pregnancy. Indiana ranked 49th in service availability, 42nd in laws and policies and 35th in public funding—for a 49th overall placement.

Public policy initiatives include:

- Grassroots organizing around such issues as pharmacist refusals to dispense contraceptives
- Legislative action through sister organization Planned Parenthood Advocates of Indiana
- Get Real, Indiana! coalition for comprehensive, medically-accurate sex education
- Planned Parenthood Action Network—an e-mail alert system
- Live Action Camps—grassroots advocacy training
- Voter registration

Organizational Structure

Planned Parenthood of Indiana is a private, not-for-profit organization—501 (c)(3) tax exempt charity. The current annual report is located on our website, www.ppin.org. President and CEO Betty Cockrum has led the agency since 2002.

The agency is governed by a 24-member board of directors that is geographically represented in the areas we serve. The board meets quarterly with the annual meeting of all members occurring each November.

Planned Parenthood of Indiana is an accredited organization subject to a formal review process every four years by governing organization PPFA.
